A Message from our President & CEO and Chairman of the Board

Together, We Give Families Hope!

Roy had five major surgeries and couldn't work to feed his family. Deborah struggled with MS and worried about choosing groceries or medicine. Colin and his wife's salaries weren't enough to cover daycare and food. Fortunately their stories and countless others had nourishing endings because, for 39 years, Food Bank of the Rockies has worked to ensure no one in our service area goes without food.

From our humble beginnings in a one room school house, receiving bread from a nearby Safeway, our first donor, to share with our first partner agency, Little Sisters of the Poor, our mission to feed the hungry has never changed. But our distribution has! Thanks to generous donors, nearly 49 million meals were served to hungry men, women and children last year. And for the first time ever, a quarter of the food we distributed was fresh produce. Our focus on nutrition continues to grow!

We've added new food donors to our mix and expanded the food bank's and our partner agencies' capacity. Together, we've rescued more than 18 million pounds of nutritious food from retailers, filling the pantries and plates of neighbors who need our help.

Programs like Totes of Hope®, Kids Cafe, Senior Food Boxes and our Mobile Pantry remain strong. Together with our partner agencies, we continue to feed our community. Because you care, we've reached milestones that were unimaginable 39 years ago. Solving hunger is a daunting task and we're so grateful for every contributor of food, funds and time. We take hunger seriously and we're glad you're here to help us meet the needs of far too many Colorado and Wyoming families who face difficult choices.

We continue to be good stewards of your gifts, once again receiving BBB accreditation and another 4-Star (highest) rating from Charity Navigator. This, our 8th consecutive 4-star rating, keeps us in the top 2% of charities nationwide. 96 cents of every dollar we receive goes toward food distribution. And we're still able to provide four meals with every dollar. Thank you – your gifts brought hope to more than 400,000 people last year! Together we can fight hunger. Together we can feed hope.





Each year, we select one outstanding volunteer who exemplifies Betty's enthusiasm, heart and commitment. We are pleased to present this year's award to Chuck Johnson.

Six years ago, Chuck was down on his luck. Unemployed and fighting depression, he sat in church one Sunday morning and noticed a flyer. His church could get additional food credits for their pantry when people volunteered on their behalf at Food Bank of the Rockies. Chuck decided to give it a try. He met with Vic, FBR's Reclamation Specialist at the time, who partnered him with Ron Torpy and Paul Berteau, both Betty Van Hook award recipients. Chuck felt welcome and found his volunteer home. Vic nicknamed the three his "A Team." Chuck knew his work made a difference, not only for the food bank and his church's pantry, but also for his spirit.

A year later, he found a new job and continued to volunteer on Saturdays. Now retired, we are lucky to have Chuck volunteer on Tuesdays and Thursdays too.

Since 2011, Chuck has contributed more than 1,400 hours to help us feed hungry people. His pantry has distributed almost 23,000 more meals because of his efforts. We appreciate his kindness and are so grateful he's part of our volunteer family. Congratulations Chuck!

Food Bank of the Rockies' Endowment

Our Future is in Good Hands



Elmer "Bud" Ferdon



One man can change the lives of so many, even after he's gone. We're grateful to tell Bud's story of inspiration and his generosity and thank his grandson, Loren Verville, for sharing this story with us.

Bud grew up in Wisconsin. His parents struggled to provide for their children but always did the best they could. Growing up, Bud's family received food assistance from the Salvation Army. He witnessed his parents' struggle to put food on the table and experienced first-hand how charities could help families like his during difficult times. This left a mark on him and contributed to his desire to do something with his life.

Bud built a successful injection molding business, and Loren shares that Bud didn't have overnight success. "It wasn't really until later in his life that he came into true success financially, but his businesses were always healthy even

through major industry shifts" he tells us. Bud's first business was a small plastic molding company in Illinois. His love of the great outdoors prompted a move to Colorado in the 1960s.

Bud's new business, Mountain Molding, began in Berthoud and later relocated to a new location in Mead. At a time when injection molding trended moving overseas, Bud and his partner Don Cheyne found their niche producing medical-grade parts that needed to be made in the United States. Bud and Don figured out a way to not only survive, but to thrive.

Bud was selective about the charities he chose to support. "He put a lot of effort into vetting where he gave his money and his time and his resources, and Food Bank came up to speed in all of those areas," Loren shares. Bud chose to support Food Bank of the Rockies because he thought FBR did a wonderful job using donations efficiently. Bud liked being able to see how all the dollars went to work directly improving people's lives through food.

A very social person, Bud encouraged his circle of friends and acquaintances to support FBR too. Loren explains, "If you wanted to try to figure out a way to give back or wanted to give to a good cause or support something but you weren't sure what to do, talk to Bud! He'd point you in the right direction." Bud's friends trusted that he'd spent time and energy learning about charities that were doing good things with their money and things that mattered to people in need.

"He was deadly serious that there not be a funeral, that there be a party instead," Loren says about his grandfather, who knew cancer's return meant his time was limited. "And so we did that—we got a couple hundred people or so at a park and had a party. We told stories about his life...! don't think a lot of people realized all he had truly done for individuals until the actual stories were coming out."

Bud was humble and helped others in a quiet way. He worked hard to build his business and his generous bequest isn't about name legacy as much as it is about giving value and worth to the intense amount of work he did to put everything together. He wanted others to have a chance at success, supporting hunger relief and education, so people could make it through the day and eventually live fulfilled lives and fly on their own.

What lessons did Loren learn from his grandfather? "The details matter," he shares. "Pay attention to those little, small things. Prepare for the worst but hope for the best. It sounds cliché, but it's his thumbprint—that mindset is on everything that he did."

Loren expresses one parting thought with us, "Bud's extended family, we're all very proud of the bequest that's been made to Food Bank of the Rockies, in addition to other charities as well. It is a good thing... We know it's a part of the legacy, both for Bud and for the family overall. We're all just thrilled to vicariously partner with you guys through the gift that he made."

Thank you Bud for the many years you helped us while you were here and now for leaving this incredible legacy. It makes a tremendous difference for our food bank and our mission to help families thrive. Because you cared so much, struggling men, woman and children have more hope for a better future. We'll remember you always in gratitude!
